







Liselund Palace

The thatched Liseland Palace can be admired from the outside and inside and is located directly on the cliffs near Møns Klint.

A romantic garden with a Chinese tea house, dreamy avenues and lakes full of water lilies nestles in Denmark's smallest and enchanted summer palace is inviting you to walk, dream and linger all the year around. The garden was created for the nobles Antoine and Lisa de la Calmette in the late 17th century as a scene for great worldly thought and spiritual life.

Visitors can also visit the palace on guided tours and marvel at the artistically furnished rooms.

Season:

The romantic garden is open all year and admission is free. Liselund Palace is open May 1st – September 30th. The castle can only be visited with a guided tour.
